Swift Teamwork Leads to Stolen Vehicle Recovery!



An alert was triggered on our NAVIC system for a stolen vehicle. Our vigilant controller immediately notified responder Zipho, who sprang into action and headed straight to Victoria Street.

Zipho quickly spotted the white Toyota Conquest matching the stolen vehicle's description. Backup was called in, and the vehicle with three occupants was safely stopped.

Upon interception, the driver and front passenger fled the scene in opposite directions, leaving a female passenger behind. The scene was promptly secured and handed over to Somerset SAPS Sgt Joseph for further investigation.

Thanks to seamless coordination between our NAVIC alert system, alert controllers, and rapid-response team, another stolen vehicle is off the streets! This recovery highlights the power of integrated technology and professional teamwork in action. Our LPR systems, surveillance solutions, and 24/7 monitoring continue to deliver results for estates and neighbourhoods across the region.

More success stories like this are rolling out in additional areas as we expand our advanced security installations.

Armed Response Officer Daniels responded to a silent panic alarm at a residence in Paarl.

While checking the premises, he discovered a male suspect hiding in a tree. Paarl SAPS was notified, and a case of trespassing was opened.



Armed Response Officer Roland observed a suspicious male emerging from behind our offices in Paarl, heading towards the train station.

When Officer Roland attempted to approach him, the suspect dropped the bicycle and fled on foot.

The bicycle was recovered and taken to our office, where it was successfully reunited with its rightful owner, Mr. Grobbelaar.



The homeowner, Mr. Bierman, reported that a suspect entered through an open window and stole a cellphone.

Using tracker updates from the stolen phone, officers located and pursued the suspect on foot, with Meyers, Blankenberg, Jacobs, and Marais involved.

The suspect was detained, SAPS arrived, and the cellphone plus a stolen torch were recovered. Police returned the suspect to the premises to check for other missing items. The case was handed over to SAPS.

A vehicle linked to fraud cases in Caledon and Hermanus was flagged on our advanced ANPR (Automatic Number Plate Recognition) system. Alerts began triggering as early as Friday, but the suspect proved elusive, narrowly evading our responders each time.

On Monday evening, the vehicle started generating multiple hits across the Strand and Somerset West areas. Our determined team stayed on the chase until around 21:00, when a final alert came from an ANPR camera in Vergelegen Plein.

With perfect timing, our response units already en-route to the suspect's last known location, quickly converged, located the vehicle, and safely blocked it in. Multiple Vetus Schola members secured the scene while coordinating with the SAPS Investigating Team and local Somerset West officers.

Upon SAPS arrival, the scene was professionally handed over for further action.

Well done to every team member involved, your persistence, coordination, and professionalism turned repeated alerts into a successful apprehension!

This case demonstrates the real power of our integrated ANPR technology combined with relentless on-the-ground response. We're proud to play a key role in removing wanted vehicles and suspects from our roads.

As we continue rolling out more advanced systems across the region, stories like this are becoming the standard.

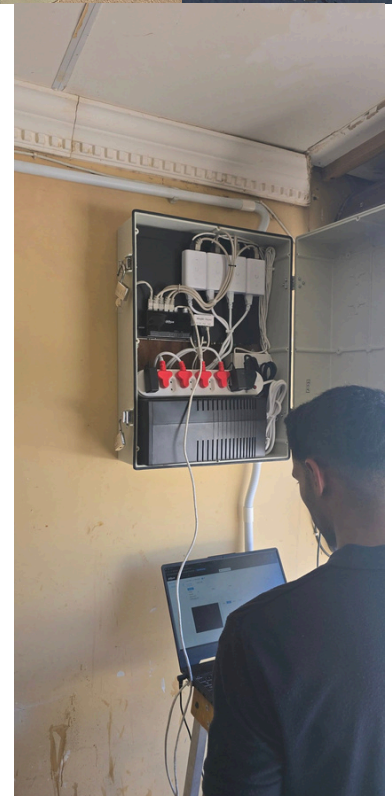

In the security industry, teamwork is everything. Whether you're on patrol, monitoring surveillance, or managing client sites, how we handle disagreements with coworkers directly impacts safety, morale, and client trust.

Practical Tips for Managing Conflict

- **Address Issues Early:** Don't let frustrations build up. Speak calmly with your coworker before small issues grow into bigger problems.
- **Respect Differences:** South Africa's diverse workforce brings different languages, cultures, and perspectives. Approach differences with curiosity, not judgment.
- **Stay Professional:** Avoid gossip or negative talk. Keep discussions focused on the situation, not personalities.
- **Use "I" Statements:** Say "I feel concerned when..." instead of "You always..." to reduce defensiveness.
- **Seek Mediation:** If conflict persists, involve a supervisor or HR to help resolve matters fairly.

SAFETY AND SECURITY TIPS

As we celebrate the holidays and welcome 2026, the Vetus Schola Group team wishes you a joyful and safe festive season. While this is a time for relaxation and family gatherings, it's also when opportunistic crime can increase. Drawing from our experience providing 24/7 armed response, advanced LPR/ANPR systems, alarms, and K9 units across the Helderberg, Drakenstein, Paarl, and Western Cape, here are practical tips to help keep you, your loved ones, and your property protected.

Home Security Tips (Especially When Away on Holiday)

- Make your home look occupied. Use timers for lights, radios, or TVs. Ask a trusted neighbour to collect mail and check on the property.
- Test your alarm system. Ensure it's armed, batteries are charged (load-shedding proof) and your armed response provider (like us!) has updated contact details.
- Secure all entry points. Lock doors/windows, activate burglar bars, and close garage doors. Avoid leaving keys in hidden spots.
- Don't advertise your absence. Avoid posting holiday plans or photos on social media in real-time.
- Exterior lighting & visibility. Keep outside lights on or use motion sensors to deter intruders.

Personal Safety Tips

- Be aware of your surroundings. Stay alert in crowded places, malls, or ATMs. Avoid distractions like phones.
- Travel in groups. Especially at night or in unfamiliar areas. Safety in numbers!
- Protect your belongings. Keep bags close, wallets in front pockets, and never leave valuables visible in your car.
- Watch your drinks. At parties or events, never leave them unattended.
- Plan safe transport. Use trusted e-hailing services, verify details, and share your trip with someone.

Vehicle & Road Safety Tips

- Hide valuables. Never leave items visible. Smash-and-grab incidents spike this season.
- Vehicle checks. Inspect tyres, brakes, fluids, and lights before long trips.
- Avoid driving impaired. Plan ahead with a designated driver or rideshare.
- Leave space. At traffic lights, keep a gap to maneuver if needed.
- Emergency kit. Carry water, a torch, reflective triangle, and a charged phone.

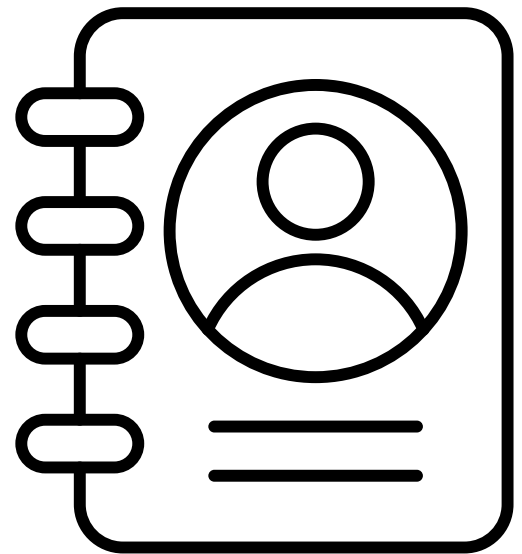

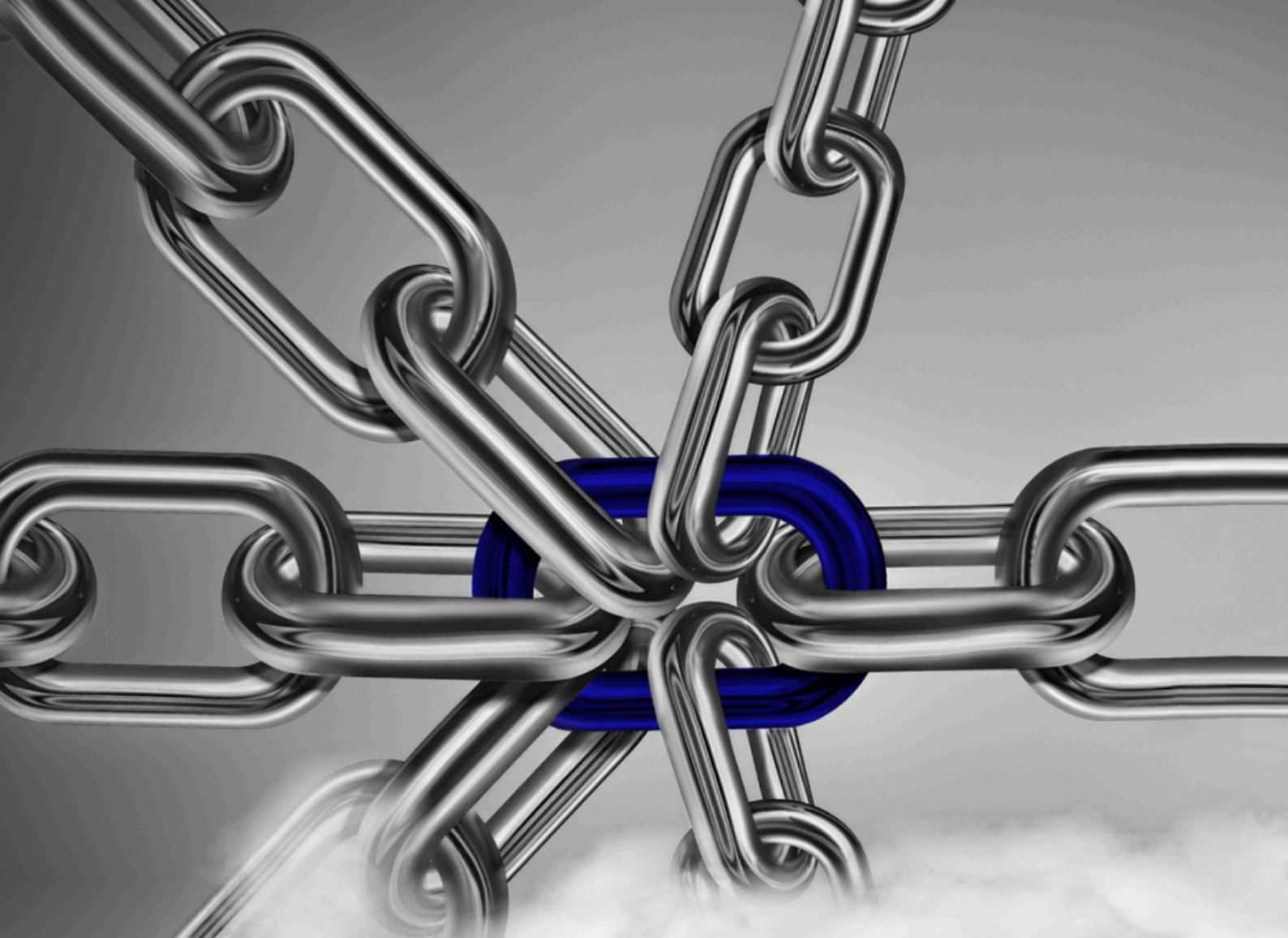
